Terms & Conditions

The following terms and conditions are the basis upon which driving lessons and courses are offered to you at Barkers Learners:

Driving Licence

 You must hold a current and valid, provisional or full driving licence (both photo-card and paper counterpart), which must be produced at the first lesson

Driving Lessons

 No lessons at Barkers Learners will be overlapped with another student, therefore students can be assured that their in-car tuition will be on an individual one-to-one basis.

Driving Tests

- Driving tests can be booked by you or your instructor
- The instructor reserves the right to withhold the use of his car for a test if in his opinion, your driving is potentially dangerous, or you are not at test standard
- If you need to postpone or cancel a test, then you are required by the DSA (Driving Standards Agency) to give at least three working days notice
- The instructor cannot be held responsible for any postponement or cancellation of tests by the DSA
- If the tuition vehicle is damaged by the student during their driving test, then a charge of £50 will incurred

Cancellation of a Driving Lesson (including 10 hour Block Bookings)

- If you need to cancel or postpone your lesson, then at least 24 hrs notice is required (regardless of the circumstances), via a phone call, text or voicemail to (07956) 263978.
- If 24 hrs notice of cancellation has not be given, then the <u>standard £10 charge will be</u> <u>incurred, or ½ hour will be deducted from a block booking</u> (to cover loss of earnings and/or petrol), which you will need to pay at the start of your next driving lesson
- Please ensure that you are punctual for your lessons. Your instructor will normally wait
 for a maximum of 15 minutes before the lesson will be abandoned, and the <u>standard £10</u>
 charge will be incurred.
- If the instructor is delayed or has to cancel a lesson due to unforeseen circumstances (e.g. sickness, mechanical failure, heavy traffic, etc), then any lesson time lost as a result of this will be made up by the instructor, either at the end of that lesson (where possible), or at a later date

Intense Course Booking Conditions

Intense courses require the instructor to reserve a considerable amount of time in their diary, therefore the following terms and conditions apply:

- A <u>non-refundable deposit</u> is required on booking, amounting to 50% of the course fee.
- Once the dates and lesson times have been agreed, these will be sent to the student along with a receipt for the deposit paid.
- An intense course can only be postponed by the student, if there is at least 4 weeks notice given.
- The final payment for the intense course will be required by the instructor on arrival at the first lesson (or before).
- As intense courses require a high volume of the instructor's time over a short period, any lessons missed by the student once the intense course has started, will be non-refundable.
